

NEW in the MEB PROGRAMME

EARN a MASTER'S OF SCIENCE (MSc) in BERLIN

Starting in the 2008/09 Academic Year, students spending Semester 2 in Berlin can elect to work towards a dual degree of Master's of Science (MSc) and MEB.

If you choose the MSc track (Berlin only), you will need a minimum of 15 months to complete your dual degree. Upon completion of Semester 2 in Berlin, you will remain in Berlin for a Semester 3 "Research Methods" and "Master's Thesis" module from July to September, followed by a minimum of 12 weeks of internship.

If you do not choose the MSc track, you will be awarded the MEB degree upon successful completion of all MEB requirements.

PERIOD	CONTENTS of the BERLIN DUAL DEGREE (MSc TRACK)
Semester 1 September to February	Management Courses and Company Consultancy Project I (any MEB campus other than Berlin)
Semester 2 February to June	Management Courses and Company Consultancy Project II (Berlin only)
Semester 3 July to September	Research Methods, Master's Thesis (Berlin only)
Semester 3 September to December	Company internship (12 weeks minimum)

Research Methods: Familiarise yourself with the key elements of the research process. Learn how to formulate a research question and to set up an adequate research design.

Master's Thesis: Apply your management knowledge and methodological skills to a specific research question over a two-month period.

Please note that while the MEB Semester 2 in Berlin is taught in German, the MSc Master's Thesis can be written in English.

The MEB degree is one of only 27 European programmes accredited in the category of "Masters in Business and Management" by AMBA, and is officially recognised as 'Grade de Master' by the French Ministry of Education*. ESCP-EAP is also accredited by AACSB and EQUIS (EFMD), thus achieving the 'triple crown' for top international business schools.



* The French "Grade de Master" can only be awarded to students with a four-year undergraduate degree who have studied in Paris for one of the two MEB semesters.
